Emergency Rectory Repair Update

As you already know, the Diocese Building Inspector has

declared our rectory unsafe. Necessary repairs are needed to bring it up to standards. Repairs needed are: Upgrade electrical system, rat and mice extermination, repairs to the ceiling, interior walls and windows and replacing appliances. Work has already began to address these areas. The total estimate needed is \$25,000. As of April 6, we have raised \$12,698.00 including the matching fund that was donated. Cost does not include labor since volunteers have come out to assist in the repairs. We ask that everyone be generous this season of Lent and contribute to this great cause.
