Emergency Rectory
Repair**

As you already know, the Diocese Building Inspector has declared our rectory unsafe. Necessary repairs are needed to bring it up to standards. Repairs needed are: Upgrade electrical system, rat and mice extermination, repairs to the ceiling, interior walls and windows and replacing appliances. The total estimate needed is \$25,000, not including labor. An anonymous donor will match up to \$5,000 for every dollar donated towards this goal. We ask that everyone be generous this season of Lent and contribute to this great cause.
