#### Holy Mary Mother of God, Accompany and Intercede for Us This Year



Today is a special day for all of us. So, happy New Year, and feast day of Mary, Mother of God. We give thanks to God for today's celebrations, both of which are great sources of blessings. First, for the gift of a new year. Second, for the gift of a precious mother to accompany, comfort, and intercede for us throughout this year. The title "Mother of God" is from the Greek "Theotokos" (God-bearer). Through this celebration, the church reminds us of Mary's special role in God's plan. This solemnity can be traced back to the Council of Ephesus in 431. Officially, it was

celebrated first in Portugal as Mary's Divine Maternity. This was with the permission of Pope Benedict IV, in 1575.

In 1931, Pope Pius XI extended the feast to the entire church. Finally, in 1974, Pope Paul VI removed the feast of the Circumcision of Christ from the liturgical calendar on the first day of the year. He replaced it with the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God." About the important role of Mary in God's plan and today's solemnity, the Church teaches: "Mary, the all-holy and ever-virgin Mother of God, is the masterwork of the mission of the Son and the Spirit in the fullness of time. To her, let us ask the favor this year to be happy and joyful

As we entered New Year2023, we are offered new opportunities, new ideas, and new resolutions. It is a sign of regeneration and a time of new hope. Each new year, we make new resolutions. Unfortunately, we hardly keep or fulfill them. Why? Possibly, because we are always in a hurry to make them, and consequently, do not consult God about such resolutions. So, one important thing we must do this year is to resolve to strengthen our relationship with God. Proverbs tells: "Commit to the Lord whatever you do, and he will establish your plans (Pr 16, 3). Also, as the psalmist admonishes us: Commit your way to the Lord; trust in Him and He shall bring it to pass (Ps 37: 5). Therefore, this year we must develop the resilient spirit of Moses who insisted before God: "If you do not personally go with us, we shall not leave this place... (Ex 33, 15). Also, like Enoch let us walk with God (Gen 5, 27).

So, as we continue our walk with God this year, let us constantly ask for the intercession Mary, Mother of God: Oh, Holy Mother of God, despise not our prayers in our necessities, but deliver us from all dangers, Oh glorious and blessed Virgin.

Wish you Happy New Year 2023. May the Lord fill you and your family with prosperity of joy and happiness throughout this year.



## **Teaching Masses During Sunday Mass (January 8—February 19, 2023)**

All parishes are asked to do "Teaching Masses" for the next seven weeks. The topic Eucharistic Revival will assure a greater appreciation of Christ's gift of himself to us in the Eucharist, a deeper understanding of his Real Presence, and a more robust celebration of the Eucharist that will attract others to "taste and see the goodness of the Lord." As part of his homily, Father Sebastian will be concentrating on one aspect of the Eucharist at each Mass for the next seven weeks. Here is the weekly schedule:

January 7-8 (Epiphany of the Lord) General reflection on the Mass as a living encounter with Jesus, January 14 –15 (Second Sunday of Ordinary Time) Reflection om the Introduction of the Mass January 21-22 (Third Sunday of Ordinary Time) Reflection on the Liturgy of the Word January 28-28 (Fourth Sunday of Ordinary Time) Reflection on the Liturgy of the Eucharist, Part A February 4-5 (Fifth Sunday of Ordinary Time) Reflection on the Liturgy of the Eucharist, Part B February 11-12 (Sixth Sunday of Ordinary Time) Reflection on Concluding Rites February 18-19 (Seventh Sunday of Ordinary Time) General Review of preceding weeks

We are prepared to provide and distribute handouts to reinforce the catechesis each week.
