#### Emergency Rectory Repair



The Diocese Building Inspector has declared our rectory unsafe. Repairs needed are as follows: Electrical System does not conform to state's building code, presenting a fire

hazard, rat and mice extermination, ceiling, interior walls and windows needs to be replaced, and replacing appliances. The total estimate needed is \$25,000, not including labor. An anonymous donor will match up to \$5,000 for every dollar donated towards this goal. We ask that everyone be generous this season of Lent and contribute to this great cause.
