Dear Brothers and Sisters in the Risen Lord,

Secondly, I ask you all to pray for the success of our parish hall cement concrete this Sunday afternoon. On this 5th Sunday of Easter, in a special way, the Church reminds us of who we are: "The chosen race and the royal priesthood, who would be and reign with Christ. Today we have gathered to exercise our royal priesthood by offering a spiritual sacrifice as Christ did.

Peter reminds us of who we truly are: "A chosen race, a royal priesthood, a consecrated nation, a people set apart to sing the praises if God..." Here, Peter highlights our participation in the priesthood of Christ through the "common or general priest priesthood." This is certainly by virtue of our baptism (CCC1268). Baptism configures us to become "priests."

In today's gospel, Jesus assures us of a place in his kingdom: "Let not your hearts be troubled...there are many rooms in my father's house...so that where I am you may be too." This is a clear indication that by virtue of baptism we are truly children of God. This is why he considers us worthy of being where he is going to be.

Unfortunately, many of us do not know who we are, or believe that there is a beautiful place being prepared for us by Christ. This is also the reason many of us cannot maximize our priestly and royal potentials. As priests and people of royal decent, we must assert ourselves positively. It takes faith to do this.

Therefore, let us ask God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ to help us live as members of the royal priesthood. Also, during this, this glorious and gracious season of Easter, let us: "Rejoice in the Lord" for what God has done for us.
